Our Guest Housing apartments are available at E.S. King Village with a very limited number of units available elsewhere on campus. All our units feature a private bathroom and a personal efficiency kitchen and living area.

**Eligibility**

Guests must be affiliated with the University as:

- A visiting faculty/staff member
- A sponsored guest of an NC State department or current faculty/staff member
- A prospective student during an official university visit
- A private guest of an NC State University employee or current University Housing resident.

**Reservations**

Guest housing is limited to stays of a **minimum of 5 nights and maximum of four months**. Reservations must be made via our registration portal at least one week prior to your requested arrival date. Reservation requests are reviewed in the order of which they are received. After submitting an online request, a confirmation email will be sent your way if a room is available for the dates you indicated. If space is not available, you will receive an email indicating as such. You can expect a response within 2-4 business days after we receive your request.
